What you need to know...

Applications: Students apply to the BCPS Magnet Office. They may apply to three programs.

Assessments are held in December and January. Applicants will make their assessment appointments online on the magnet application website.

Transportation: School Day is from 7:45-2:30. Students are picked up at their local high schools between 6:30 and 7:00 am.

Daily Schedule: Students take their prime classes every day and their academics on alternating days. Carver Center follows a 4-period A-B day schedule. Students will also attend Wildcat Time each day (this is a 30 minute block in which the students sign up with teachers in order to complete assignments, get extra help, redo assignments, use as a study hall, etc.)

Academic Courses are offered at the AP, GT, Honors, and Standard levels.

College Information: 96% of the class of 2023 attends 2 and 4 year colleges. They were offered over \$28,856,788.00 in scholarships. The class of 2023 also had a 100% graduation rate.

SAT and AP Information: SAT verbal scores and combined verbal/math mean scores exceed countywide, state, and national averages. 84% of the AP students had Advanced Placement scores that qualified students for college credit, placing Carver Center on the list of top high schools according to The Washington Post, Newsweek and US News.

Clubs and Sports: Carver Center offers most sports except for football. After school clubs include SGA, Black Awareness Club, Key Club, National Honor Society, and many others.
